<b>Date and Time Potential Critical Contingency Notified:</b>	17:15 on 15 February 2023
<b>Potential critical contingency caused by:</b>	A land slip has exposed a section of the Firstgas Transmission Pipeline near Gisborne. The pipeline is at increased risk until remedial action to stabilise, inspect and repair the pipeline can be completed.
<b>Transmission pipeline(s) affected:</b>	The Firstgas Transmission Pipeline supplying the Gisborne Delivery Point.
<b>Geographic area affected:</b>	Gisborne
<b>Details of Event resolution:</b>	<p>Firstgas personnel have made progress to stabilise, inspect, and repair the pipeline and work is on-going.</p> <p>As a precautionary measure, the operating pressure in the affected section of pipeline is still being manually controlled and monitored until repairs can be completed.</p>
<b>Estimated Time to repair underlying problem (if known):</b>	It is estimated that the pipeline will be restored to normal operating pressure within the next 24 hours.
<b>CCO actions being taken to stabilise the gas system:</b>	<p>A critical contingency has not been declared.</p> <p>The critical contingency pressure threshold at the Gisborne Delivery Point has not been breached.</p> <p>The CCO will only declare a critical contingency if the pressure threshold is breached, or a breach is considered unavoidable.</p>
<b>Other Information:</b>	The CCO will provide an update on this event by 1pm tomorrow at the latest, or sooner if material information is obtained.

This notice is supplementary to the other notices issued by the CCO during a critical contingency.

This notice does not contain any directions or declarations and is published to provide more information and forecasts about the status of the critical contingency.

The information contained in Status Update Notices is based on the best information/knowledge available to the CCO at the time of publication and may vary over the duration of the event as the situation changes/develops.
